SECTION 600.080 AND SECTION 600.160 FEES

(CHECK APPLICABLE)

1. _____ For each license for the sale at retail of intoxicating liquor in the original package not to be consumed nor the original package opened on the premises where sold, there shall be paid the sum of Fifty dollars (\$50.00) per each twelve months.

2. _____ For each license of the sale at retail of malt liquor containing alcohol in excess of three and two-tenths percent by weight and not in excess of five percent by weight in connection with a grocer, store, general store or other business, in the original package not to be consumed nor the original package opened on the premises where sold, there shall be paid the sum of Eleven dollars and Twenty-five Cents shall be paid the sum of Eleven Dollars and Twenty-five Cents (\$ 11.25) per each six months. This license shall also permit the holder thereof to sell nonintoxicating beer in the original package direct to consumers but not for resale.

3. _____ For each license issued under the provisions of this Ordinance for the sale at retail by the drink to be consumed on the premises where sold of all intoxicating liquor and for the sale of all intoxicating liquor in the original package, there shall be paid the sum of Three Hundred dollars (\$300.00) per each twelve months.

4. _____ For each license issued under the provisions of this Ordinance for the sale at retail by the drink to be consumed on the premises where sold of all intoxicating liquor and for the sale of all intoxicating liquor in the original package there shall be paid the sum of Three Hundred Dollars (\$ 300.00) per each twelve months, with an additional One Hundred Dollars (\$ 100.00) paid for the privilege of selling liquor on Sunday per each twelve months.

5. _____ For each license for the sale at retail by the drink, to be consumed on the premises where sold, malt liquor containing alcohol in excess of three and two-tenths percent by weight and not in excess of five percent by weight, there shall be paid the sum of Twenty-Six Dollars and twenty-five cents (\$ 26.25) per each six months, with an additional One Hundred Dollars (\$ 100.00) paid for the privilege of selling liquor on Sunday per each twelve months. This license may also include light wines not in excess of 14% of alcohol by weight for consumption of the premises.

6. _____ The holder of any such license may also apply for a special license to sell intoxicating liquor, at retail, in the original package, not to be consumed on the premises where sold, between the hours of 1:00 P.M. and midnight on Sundays. The special license fee shall be the sum of three hundred dollars (\$ 300.00) a year. Such application does not require separate approval by the City Council, and the special license provided for herein may be issued forthwith upon the receipt of the application (Voted by the people and passed April 5, 1994.)
